Re: AB 2387 (Vargas): Insurance Agents: Education *As Amended May 3, 2006*
Senate Banking, Finance and Insurance Committee: June 21, 2006
PIFC Position: Support

The Personal Insurance Federation of California (PIFC), representing insurers who write nearly 50% of all personal lines insurance sold in California, including State Farm, Farmers, Safeco, Progressive, 21st Century and NAMIC, **supports AB 2387** (Vargas) which would allow insurance agents to take classes on-line.

Under current law, insurance agents must obtain their pre-licensing training in a "classroom." AB 2387 is an enlightened measure that recognizes that, with the widespread acceptance of the internet, a quality education can be obtained "on-line" and outside the traditional classroom. Many institutes of higher learning appreciate the fact that on-line education works well. Therefore, it is appropriate that the Department of Insurance adopt on-line education as a way to train insurance agents.

In addition, the author correctly notes that allowing insurance agents to obtain their education on-line will increase the number of agents who are able to work within their own communities. The societal benefit of this is that consumers will be able to literally turn to their neighbors for vital insurance products.
