The Personal Insurance Federation of California, representing insurers who write 44% of the auto insurance sold in the state, including Farmers, 21st Century, Safeco, Progressive, State Farm and NAMIC, **supports Assembly Bill 254**, authored by the Assembly Member Ted Gaines.

AB 254 would work to create a "flooded" title designation for California salvage vehicles. The goal of the bill is to make sure California's titling laws are in sync with those other states that have a "flooded" title designation. It is necessary for consumer protection that these vehicles are properly branded. Consumers should be aware that the cars they are buying were previously a salvage vehicle due to flood.
