Re: Notice of Modification of Proposed Regulations
Title 13, Article 3.0, Sections 155.05 and 155.07
Total Loss Salvage and Nonrepairable Vehicles

In accordance with Government Code section 11346.8(c), the Department of Motor Vehicles (department) provides this notice for the purpose of inviting comments regarding modification of the proposed regulations governing the application process for issuance of a total loss salvage or nonrepairable vehicle certificate. The regulatory language as originally proposed was published in the California Regulatory Notice Register on January 30, 2009, and provided to interested persons for comment.

The department received one comment during the 45-day comment period. After reviewing the comment, the department has determined that additional modifications to the originally proposed text of the regulations are necessary.

Attached is the full text of the proposed regulation. The text includes the originally proposed language as well as the proposed changes to the language. The proposed modifications affect Sections 155.05 and 155.07. The language modifications are clearly illustrated by the following methods:

- (1) The language originally proposed to be added to the text is single underlined.
- (2) ~~The language originally proposed to be deleted from the text is overstruck.~~
- (3) The language now proposed to be added to the original text is double underlined.
- (4) ~~The language now proposed to be deleted which was originally proposed to be added is overstruck and single underlined.~~

Any interested person may submit written comments regarding the changes to the proposed text to the Department of Motor Vehicles, Regulations Unit C-244, PO Box 932382, Sacramento, California 94232-3820. The comments must be received at the department no later than 5:00 pm on **AUGUST 13, 2009**, in order for them to be considered by the department.
