PIFC Position: Support

The Personal Insurance Federation of California, representing seven of the nation's largest insurance companies (State Farm, Farmers, Liberty Mutual Insurance, Progressive, Allstate, Mercury and Nationwide) who collectively write a majority of the personal line auto and home insurance in California, supports SB 602, Seismic Safety: California Earthquake Authority, by Senator Bill Monning.

SB 602 (Monning) would create an option for Californians to finance specific mitigation activities that have been proven to strengthen structural resiliency to earthquakes. The California Earthquake Authority's "Brace+Bolt" pilot program has been successful and this bill could help even more homeowners mitigate their homes.

This bill is timely, as the United States Geological Survey (USGS) recently announced that the risk of an 8.0 or greater earthquake in California, in the next 30 years, has increased due to greater understanding of faults and models predicting so-called mega-quakes.
