RE: AB 1227 (McCarthy): Insurance fraud: investigative units Senate Insurance Committee Hearing: August 23, 2004 **PIFC Position: Support** Amended August 19, 2004

The Personal Insurance Federation of California, representing insurers who write over 50% of the personal lines insurance policies sold in California, including State Farm, Farmers, SAFECO, 21st Century Insurance Group, and Progressive Insurance Company, **supports AB 1227** by Assemblyman McCarthy.

AB 1227 will give the Department of Insurance (CDI) statutory authority to impose reasonable and defined penalties on companies that fail to comply with the Special Investigations Unit (SIU) regulations. AB 1227 will also allow for greater flexibility in assessing more reasonable (rather than excessive) range of sanctions against those insurers who do not maintain a SIU to identify and investigate incidents of suspected insurance fraud. PIFC and its member companies have a long history of support for identification and investigation of fraud. Since the Bureau of State Audits criticism of the current statutory scheme, PIFC has been working with the CDI to craft penalty regulations.
