The Personal Insurance Federation of California (PIFC), representing insurers who write 55% of all homeowners' insurance sold in California, supports SB 518 authored by Senator Kehoe. PIFC is appreciative of the author's willingness to resolve several concerns that existed with previous versions of this bill. The August 25<sup>th</sup> amendments address our final concern and we are now in full support of this measure.

SB 518 would change the way California insurance companies handle the adjusting and managing of claims following major fires and catastrophic losses. Specifically, following a state of emergency or government declared disaster, SB 518 would extend additional living expense (ALE) coverage for affected homeowners and ensure that customers can readily obtain a copy of their insurance policies.

These changes will help to simplify and streamline the claims process for insurance consumers and hopefully ease some of the frustration and pain following the partial or complete loss of a home.
